Background



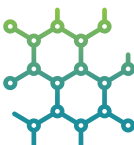
The International Chemistry Olympiad (IChO) is an annual international competition for talented young students in secondary schools and colleges. The first IChO took place in Prague in 1968. Since 1987, Switzerland has sent delegations to more than 30 IChOs but has never been a host country itself. The time has come in 2023! The Swiss Chemistry Olympiad Association (SwissChO) and ETH Zurich have been awarded the contract to host the event in Switzerland. Around 900 participants, mentors and volunteers are expected to take part in the IChO 2023 from 16–25 July 2023.

Goals



- Promoting young talents in STEM subjects - especially chemistry - with an attractive extracurricular educational programme
- Motivating young people from all over the world to study chemistry in Switzerland
- Media presence both nationally and internationally
- Public relations work on the topic of chemistry using an image campaign
- Positioning Switzerland as a leading location for education, industry and research

Project overview



- Up to 91 delegations, each with a maximum of four competitors, two mentors and some observers
- Two days of chemistry exams
- An inspiring and unforgettable programme with excursions throughout Switzerland
- Around 900 participants with over 200 volunteers on duty
- Opening and closing ceremonies to frame an unforgettable Swiss experience
- Promoting international exchange and diplomatic relations
